# Be More Positive ... Fight the Human Tendency to Focus on the Negative

The human brain has a natural tendency to give weight to (and remember) negative experiences or interactions more than positive ones—they stand out more. Psychologists refer to this as negativity bias. "Our <u>brains are wired to scout for the bad stuff</u>" and fixate on the threat, says psychologist and author Rick Hanson.


