I. Principles of Corporate Worship

1. A major key in Corporate Worship is unity.
 - We must dwel together in unity (Psalm 133:1).
 - Unity requires agreement (Amos 3:3; Matthew 16:19, 18:18-20).
 - Means every member is plugged into the body-life.
 - All to make every effort-strive for unity in the Spirit (Ephesians 4:3).
 - All part of the One Body led by One Spirit to the One Lord and God (Ephesians 4:4-6).

I. Principles of Corporate Worship

1. A major key in Corporate Worship is unity.
 - In worship, we do things together - clap, sing, read, pray, etc.
 - We pray - emphasis on the corporate gathering over the individual.
 - Corporate Worship together and yet we express it individually.
 - Individual expressions must never override or distract or disrupt the corporate expression
e.g. loudness, shouting, tongues, gestures, etc., orchestra.
 - Never make any expression an issue
e.g. tongues; hand raising ...

I. Principles of Corporate Worship

2. The Goal of Corporate Worship is delighting the heart of Father-God.
 - Father-God is seeking true worshippers (John 4:23-24).
 - True worshippers worship in spirit (Philippians 3:3).
 - True worshippers worship in truth (notpray4 but ack-connect to Presence).

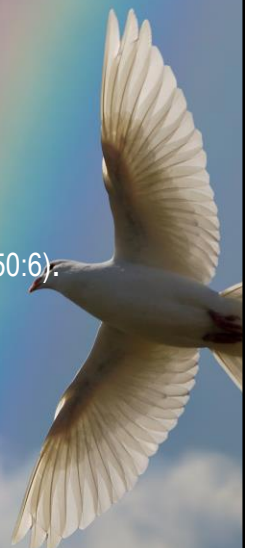
I. Principles of Corporate Worship

3. Anointed Worship means
- We do all we can (competency) but in dependency on the Holy Spirit (Philippians 3:3; Galatians 5:16, 18, 25).
 - All serving in worship team are only facilitators.
 - They do not and cannot lead us to the Presence of God.
 - Only the Holy Spirit can lead-connect us to the Presence of God.



I. Principles of Corporate Worship

3. Anointed Worship means
- We exalt the Lord Jesus always (Philippians 2:9-11).
 - We will be transformed as we worship - experience God.
 - We use every means to praise and worship the Lord (Psalm 150:6).
 - Songs - Lyrics - Musicality - Sing-ability - Author-Composer





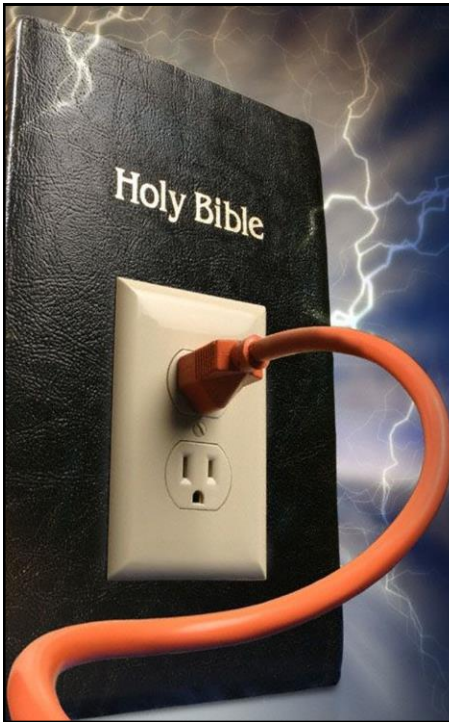

II. Confidently Connect with God

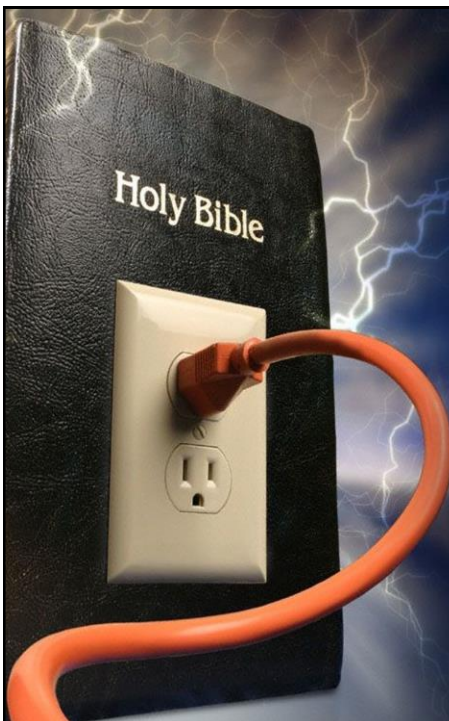
- Know that in Christ, we have right standing with God always.
- We are justified and have peace with God (Romans 5:1).
- We have the Gift of Righteousness of God (Romans 5:17; 2 Corinthians 5:21).
- We connect with God solely by the Blood of the Lamb and through Jesus, our High Priest (Hebrews 10:19-22).



II. Confidently Connect with God

- Deal with whatever sins committed.
- Receive forgiveness, cleansing and covering (1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 7:1; Romans 4:7).
- Our issue is guilt from the accusations of the evil one (Revelation 12:10; Hebrews 10:17).

Pursue a guilt-free-no condemnation relationship with God!



II. Confidently Connect with God

- Decide to worship God (Psalm 34:1, 138:1-2).
- Be a participant NOT a spectator (Michal; 2 Samuel 6:16, 23).
- Bring acceptable sacrifices (1 Peter 2:5; Romans 12:1).
- Always be guided by the Word (John 17:17) and the Spirit (John 16:13; Philippians 3:3).

II. Confidently Connect with God

- Cast all our cares and anxieties to the Lord.

1 Peter 5:7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Philippians 4:6-7

6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.



II. Confidently Connect with God


- Cast all our cares and anxieties to the Lord.

III. Thanksgiving and Praise

- We praise God for Who He is: His Attributes, His Names.

Hebrews 13:15 (NIV) - Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that confess his name. 1 Peter 2:9

Verbally - Say - Sing - Proclaim - Declare - etc.
Bodily - Dance - Move - Hands lifted - Bow - etc.

The BOTTOM-LINE of Praise is knowing God.

Exodus 34:6-7; 1 Corinthians 1:24; Isaiah 9:6; 2 Timothy 1:7

III. Thanksgiving and Praise

- Enlarge our Praise Vocabulary! Know and Experience God!
e.g. 1 - Psalm 23 (7 Redemptive Names of God)

Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. **2** He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. **3** He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. **4** Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. **5** You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. **6** Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

III. Thanksgiving and Praise

- Enlarge our Praise Vocabulary! Know and Experience God!
e.g. 2 - Psalm 103:1-5

Psalm 103:1 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! **2** Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits (68:19):
3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, **4** Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, **5** Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

- Worship has got to do with the Holiness of God.

Leviticus 10:3 And Moses said to Aaron, "This is what the Lord spoke, saying: 'By those who come near Me I must be regarded as holy'; and before all the people I must be glorified.'" So Aaron held his peace.

Isaiah 8:13 The Lord of hosts, Him you shall hallow; let Him be your fear, and let Him be your dread.

Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

- **Worship** has got to do with the **Holiness of God**.

Ephesians 5:18-19

18 ... be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.

IV. Worship, Surrender and Spiritual Songs

- Surrender and Spiritual Songs has got to do with developing intimacy with God
 - A. Directing our thoughts and emotions to God.
 - B. Giving Him our love and adoration in response to His love for us.

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

- Spontaneous expressions of our spirit that are improvised in an unrehearsed, unpremeditated manner.
- Creative expressions to tell God what we think and feel about Him.
- Born out of faith and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
- This can include personal prayer tongues.

BOTTOM-LINE

Matthew 5:8 - Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Revelation 4:8 - The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"



BOTTOM-LINE

Psalms 27:4 One thing I have desired of the LORD, that will I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His temple.



BOTTOM-LINE

Jeremiah 2:2 (NIV) Go and proclaim in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, 'Thus says the Lord, "I remember [earnestly] the lovingkindness and devotion of your youth, your time of betrothal [like that of a bride during the early years in Egypt and again at Sinai], when you followed Me in the wilderness, through a land not sown.'

God remembers no more our sins that are under the Blood!
But, He remembers our devotion to Him! 2 Corinthians 11:3
