



THE CALL TO ABIDE

ABIDE = Dwell = Connect = Remain = Deep Relationship

Psalm 91:1-2 (NKJV) 1 He who <u>dwells</u> in the secret place of the <u>Most High</u> shall <u>abide</u> under the shadow of the <u>Almighty</u>. 2 I will <u>say</u> of the <u>Lord</u>, "He is <u>my refuge and my fortress</u>; my <u>God</u>, in Him I will <u>trust</u>."







WHY the CALL to ABIDE?


- 3. <u>Abiding</u> in Him is a journey to know-experience Him.
 - Knowing God and His Ways (Jeremiah 9:23-24; Psalm 103:7; Isaiah 55:8-9)
 - Efficacy of Prayer (James 5:16) Right-Standing-Believing-Living
 - Intentionally seek His involvement in our lives
 - Confidence in relationship with God (1 John 5:14-15)



HOW to ABIDE?

MODEL of the Apostle John

He declared **5 TIMES**, in the Gospel of John, that he is "<mark>the Disciple whom Jesus loved</mark>".



- I. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops Intimacy with Him.
- II. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, Obeys Him. Obedience.
- III. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops **Passion** for God.
- **IV.** A disciple, whom Jesus loves, grows in $\underline{\mathbf{D}}$ iscernment.
- V. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, continually **Follows** the Lord.

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FIRST MENTION

John 13:23, 25 (NKJV) 23 Now there was <u>leaning on Jesus' bosom</u> one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved. 25 Then, <u>leaning back on</u> <u>Jesus' breast</u>, he said to Him, "Lord, who is it?"

I. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops <u>Intimacy</u> with Him.

Examples of Saints who developed intimacy with God


- Enoch (Genesis 5:22, 24) Raptured!

- Paul (Philippians 3:10) Mysteries Revelation (2 Corinthians 12:1-4)




HOW to develop Intimacy with God?

Relationship takes <u>time</u> and <u>effort</u> to build.

✓ We must inculcate <u>disciplines</u> to do so.











PERSONAL RESPONSE - INTIMACY

How are you currently developing your intimacy with God?

- Intake of the Word
- Prayer-connect
- Altar of Thanksgiving, Praise and Worship

I. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops **Intimacy** with Him.

- **II.** A disciple, whom Jesus loves, <u>Obeys</u> Him. <u>Obedience</u>.
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SECOND MENTION

John 19:25-27 (NKJV) 25 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the **disciple whom He loved** standing by, He said to His mother, "Woman, behold your son!" 27 Then He said to the disciple, "<u>Behold your mother</u>!" <u>And from that hour</u> that disciple took her to his own home.

II. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, Obeys Him.

II. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, <u>Obeys</u> Him.

2 Timothy 2:22 (NLT) <u>Run</u> from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, <u>pursue</u> righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the <u>companionship</u> of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts.

OBEDIENCE

We pay the price to walk in <u>righteousness</u> and <u>holiness</u>.
Separation from : everything that hinders the fulfilling of God's purpose. the things that do not value-add to our godliness.
Separation to : everything that value-add to the fulfilling of God's call. the things that will value-add to our godliness.
Relationships-Activities-Hobbies-Attitudes, etc. How you spend \$, time, energy, resources, etc.

YA-Tithe-Career

OBEDIENCE We pay the price to walk in <u>righteousness</u> and <u>holiness</u>. What is permissible for <u>others</u> may not be permissible for you. What <u>was</u> permissible may not be permissible now as your grow spiritually. Develop Fear of God (Exodus 20:20 - Flee sins) - He is Holy! New Commandment (John 13:34-35) Conscience clear before God and Man (Acts 24:16)

WHAT ARE GOD'S LAWS?

"Mandata"

= moral laws that are to be obeyed absolutely

"Exemplar"

- = examples used in parables and stories that reveal principles to follow; they are <u>not commands</u>.
- EG 1 : of Peter walking on water (FOCUS on JESUS)
- EG 2 : of Jesus telling the right young ruler to sell everything to follow Him (IDOLATRY)
- EG 3 : widow putting in 2 copper mites (SACRIFICIAL GENEROUS GIVING)

PERSONAL RESPONSE - OBEDIENCE

How am I currently walking in obedience?

- What are some areas in my life I need to separate from?
- What are some areas in my life I need to separate to?
- What was permissible for me in the past may not be permissible for me now as I walk in righteousness and holiness?

THE CALL TO ABIDE (I-O-P-D-F)

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DIADD MENDION John 20:2-4 (NKJV) 2 Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the <u>other disciple</u>, <u>whom Jesus loved</u>, and said to them, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him." 3 Peter therefore went out, and the other disciple, and were going to the tomb. 4 So they both ran together, and the other disciple, <u>the other disciple outran Peter and came to the tomb first</u>. III. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops Passion for God.

III. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops <u>Passion</u> for God.

<u>Passion</u> comes from knowing something is <u>worthwhile</u> to pursue.

III. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, develops <u>Passion</u> for God.

- Develop priorities in life to pursue your passion
 -God-People-Things (Matthew 6:33; Colossians 3:1)
- Take responsibility for own **spiritual life** and **growth**
- Be intentional-plan-prioritise-protect
- Persevere to serve God (1 Corinthians 15:58)

TIM KELLER was diagnosed with stage 4 pancreatic cancer i/v 10 Apr 2022

An encounter with your own mortality will change how you see your life, etc.

It's one thing to believe God loves you, another thing to **actually feel His love**.


It's one thing to believe He is present with you.

It's another to **actually experience His Presence** ... know the Lord ...

My experience of His Presence and His love must double, triple, quintuple or I wouldn't make it!" Billy Graham was asked if he had any regrets in life. He said yes.

He wished he had spent more time praying and studying the Bible, and less time travelling and taking speaking engagements.

He also said that he wished he had spent more time telling the Lord how much he loved Him.



PERSONAL RESPONSE - PASSION

Reflect on your current passions:

- What matters for eternity?
- What matters in the present life?
- What does not really matter at all?
- Be intentional to re-prioritise your passions.

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FOURTH MENTION

John 21:7 (NKJV) Therefore that <u>disciple whom Jesus loved</u> said to Peter, "<u>It is the Lord!</u>" Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment (for he had removed it), and plunged into the sea.

IV. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, grows from information to <u>revelation</u>.

IV. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, grows from information to <u>revelation</u>.

- John very quickly was able to perceive and recognise the resurrected Lord Jesus.
- This is because of the simplicity and purity of his heart and <u>devotion to</u> <u>the Lord</u>.
- He <u>outran</u> Peter and came to the tomb first (John 20:4).

IV. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, grows from information to <u>revelation</u>.

- He <u>saw</u> the empty tomb and <u>simply believed</u> that the Lord Jesus rose from the dead (John 20:8).
- That is why he has <u>revelation</u> and <u>spiritual discernment-perception</u>, not ordinarily available to the shallow Christian.

HOW?


APPLICATION #1

Daily ask for the **Spirit** of Wisdom and Revelation.

Ephesians 1:17-18 (NIV) 17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the <u>Spirit of wisdom and</u> <u>revelation</u>, so that you may <u>know him better</u>. 18 I pray that the <u>eyes of your heart may be enlightened</u> in order that

you may **know** the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people ...





APPLICATION #2 Seek <u>revelation</u> from your <u>intake of</u> <u>Scriptures</u>.

- Direct source of pain and sufferings.
- Don't beg-ask for Presence of God acknowledge by faith.
- Pursue a guilt-free no-condemnation relationship with God.
- No offenses be unoffendable.
- No comparison, no competition, no condemnation!



APPLICATION #2 Seek <u>revelation</u> from your <u>intake of</u> <u>Scriptures</u>.

- Ways of God Righteousness He will not override our wills
 or anyone's.
- Prayers involving the will of others.
- Our needs. Faith. Hebrews 11:6.
- 95% problems carnality.
- Strategic prayer.

APPLICATION #3 Seek wisdom from above.

James 3:17 (NKJV) But the <u>wisdom</u> that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy ...

Plenty knowledge-content But no discernment

PERSONAL RESPONSE - DISCERNMENT

Hebrews 5:14 (NKJV) But <u>solid food</u> belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by <u>reason of use</u> have their <u>senses exercised</u> to discern both good and evil.

Discernment comes from getting into the <u>meat</u> of the Word and by <u>constant practice</u>.

How am I developing discernment?

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- V. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, continually **<u>Pollows</u>** the Lord.

FIFTH MENTION

John 21:19-20 (NKJV) 19 This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him [Peter], "Follow Me." 20 Then Peter, turning around, saw the <u>disciple whom Jesus</u> loved following, who also had leaned on His breast at the supper, and said, "Lord, who is the one who betrays You?"

V. A disciple, whom Jesus loves, continually <u>follows</u> the Lord.

John 21:19-20

- Peter needed to be restored by the Lord.
- Peter has to be told by the Lord to follow Him <u>again</u>!
- Not John, because John was already following the Lord.
- History records that John lived to a ripe old age; received much revelations on the island of Patmos before he finally died in Ephesus.





Luke 9:23 (NKJV) Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. **APPLICATION #2** Build our lives on the <u>Word</u> to anchor us through <u>difficult times</u>.

Matthew 7:24-25 (NKJV) 24 Therefore whoever <u>hears</u> these sayings of Mine, and <u>does</u> them, I will liken him to a <u>wise man</u> who built his house on the rock: and 25 the <u>rain descended</u>, <u>the floods</u> <u>came</u>, <u>and the winds blew and beat on that house</u>; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

> 2 Peter 1:10; Jude 23-24 BMC Lady Cancer-Why-Allow See present pain-suffering in light of Calvary

APPLICATION #3 Walk with people who walk with God.


Hebrews 10:24-25 (NKJV) 24 And let us <u>consider</u> one another in order to <u>stir up love and good works</u>, 25 not forsaking the <u>assembling of ourselves together</u>, as is the manner of some, but <u>exhorting one another</u>, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.




PERSONAL RESPONSE - CONTINUALLY FOLLOW THE LORD

Reflect on how you handle disappointments, un-answered prayers, trouble, pain, conflicts, etc.

 so as not to stumble and fall away;
 so that you will continually follow the Lord.
