- They are prone to wander and when they go astray, they are helpless in finding their way back.

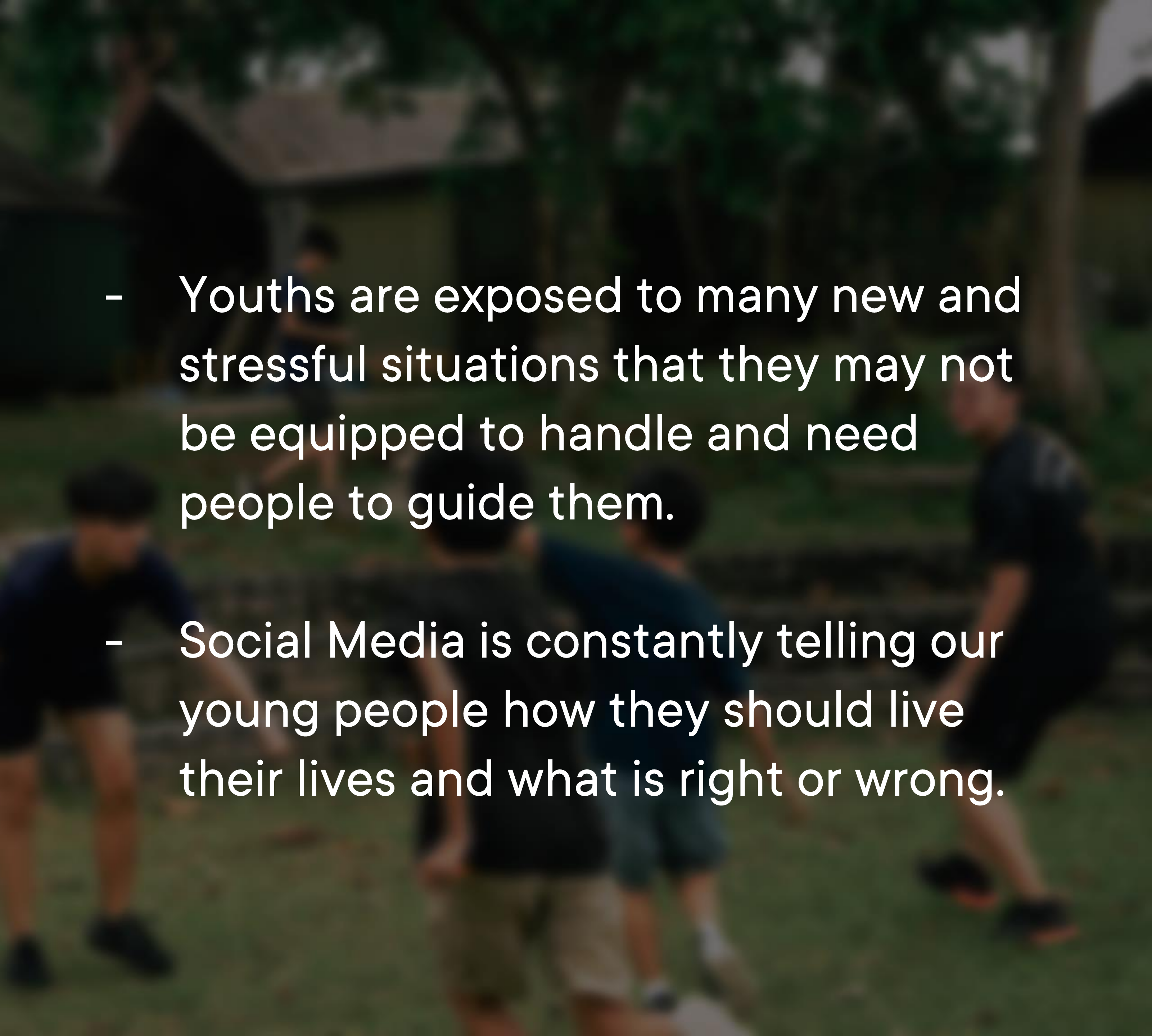




**Although there were priests, Levites and scribes all over the land, they were idol shepherds. They led the people astray instead of pointing them to God.**

- Social Media is constantly telling our young people how they should live their lives and what is right or wrong.


