

- in heaven, all 3 persons of the God-head are there and they are perfectly one.
- On earth, Jesus as Son of Man is here on two occasions
 1st coming and after 2nd coming, to establish His millennial
 Kingdom rule on earth over the nations.

- Isaiah 9:6-7 context Jesus Son of Man virgin birth 4 specific names mentioned.
- In the 2 occasions on earth, Jesus fully represents the Father.
- John 10:30 Jesus said He and the Father are one.
- John 14:9 He said anyone who has seen Him has seen the Father.
- On earth, Jesus as Son of Man is here together with the Holy Spirit whilst the Father (technically speaking) is in heaven. The Father is represented perfectly by Jesus on earth.

- When man chose to sin against God, he lost both privileges. The devil took over → access + dominion






The world is under the sway of the evil one

DARKNESS = Pain & Suffering; Grief & Sorrow

DIRECT Sources of Pain and Suffering

1. Common to Man
John 16:33; Romans 3:23

2. Due to the evil one
John 10:10a; Ephesians 4:27;
1 Peter 5:8

3. Due to our own "faults" 1 Peter 2:20; 3:17; 4:15

Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.



Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Romans 5:6, 8, 10

- 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.



What does it mean to follow Jesus?

- Believe wholeheartedly in the Lord Jesus, His Word and His Promises
- Receive His truths to nullify UGBs
- Obey and apply His Word and His promises
- Look to Him as the Light that displaces all darkness in our lives (*Psalm 27:1*)

What does it mean to follow Jesus?

- Build and grow a personal relationship with Him
- Be plugged into His body, the Church, which reflects the Light (Matthew 5:14-16)
- Submit to the authority of His Word (Psalm 119:105)
- Be led by the Holy Spirit
- Follow the Light of Life!

What happens when we follow Jesus?

- We have access to the Presence of God
- All our sins are forgiven
- We are cleansed from every defilement and sin
- We are covered by the Blood of Jesus.
 The devil cannot attack us
- We are overcomers of the world, the evil one, and our carnal self

What happens when we follow Jesus?

 - no more condemnation (Romans 8:1; Colossians 2:14-15),
 - no more curses (Galatians 3:13-14)
- We have access to the Grace, Mercy and Peace of God


