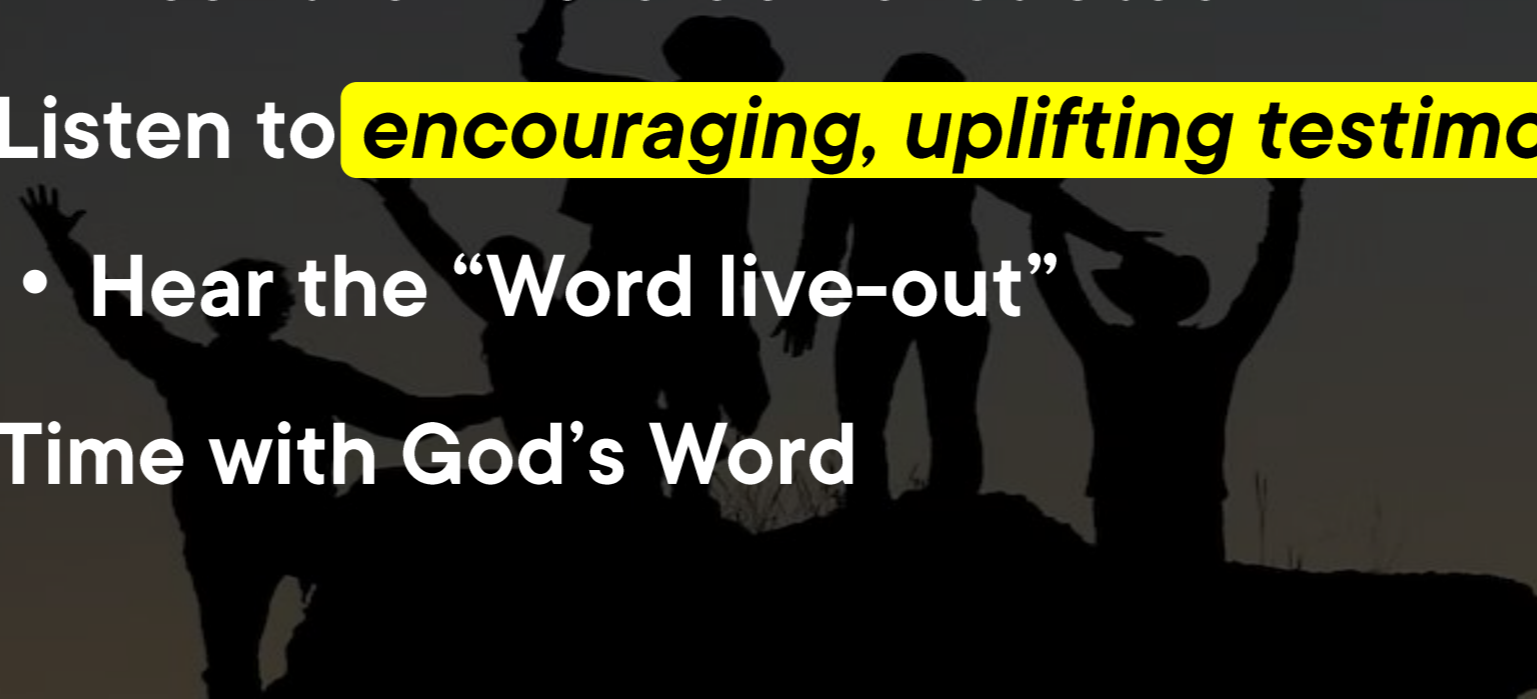

Why must we practise obedience?

MATTHEW 7:24-27

²⁴ Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock.


Why must we practise obedience?

- To **experience true learning**

HEBREWS 5:8-10


Jesus learned obedience “from what He suffered.”

As the divine Son of God, Jesus did not have to suffer, but as the Son of Man, **suffering was required to learn obedience.**


The Greek word used in Hebrews 5:8 for “suffered” usually refers to **enduring unpleasant experiences** like disease (Mark 5:26) or persecution (Acts 8:1). But it often also implies **enduring a challenging process that transforms the sufferer** (Romans 5:3; 2 Corinthians 1:3–9). That is the sense in which the word is used in Hebrews 5:8 (see also Hebrews 2:10).

HEBREWS 5:8-10

⁸ Although He was a Son, He learned obedience from the things which He suffered. ⁹ And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation, ¹⁰ being designated by God as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.



Jesus chose to endure an unpleasant, challenging process because it was the will of His Father for His brief time on earth. 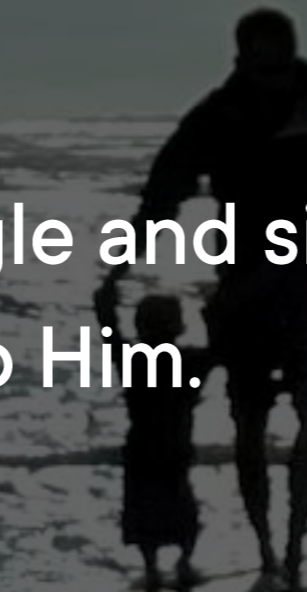
