




#### From: anon

Today, an aunty walked up to my table at a coffeeshop and asked if we could share our table. When she sat down, I asked her,


"Can I pray for you?"

One of our leaders from Hallelujah Tribe was at Bedok Central and she approached a lady to ask


"Can I pray for you?"







We should live how God wants us to every day, even if it is difficult because it pleases Him.




## "GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD"

- We need to feed ourselves with His Word for spiritual nourishment




## "GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD"

   God










