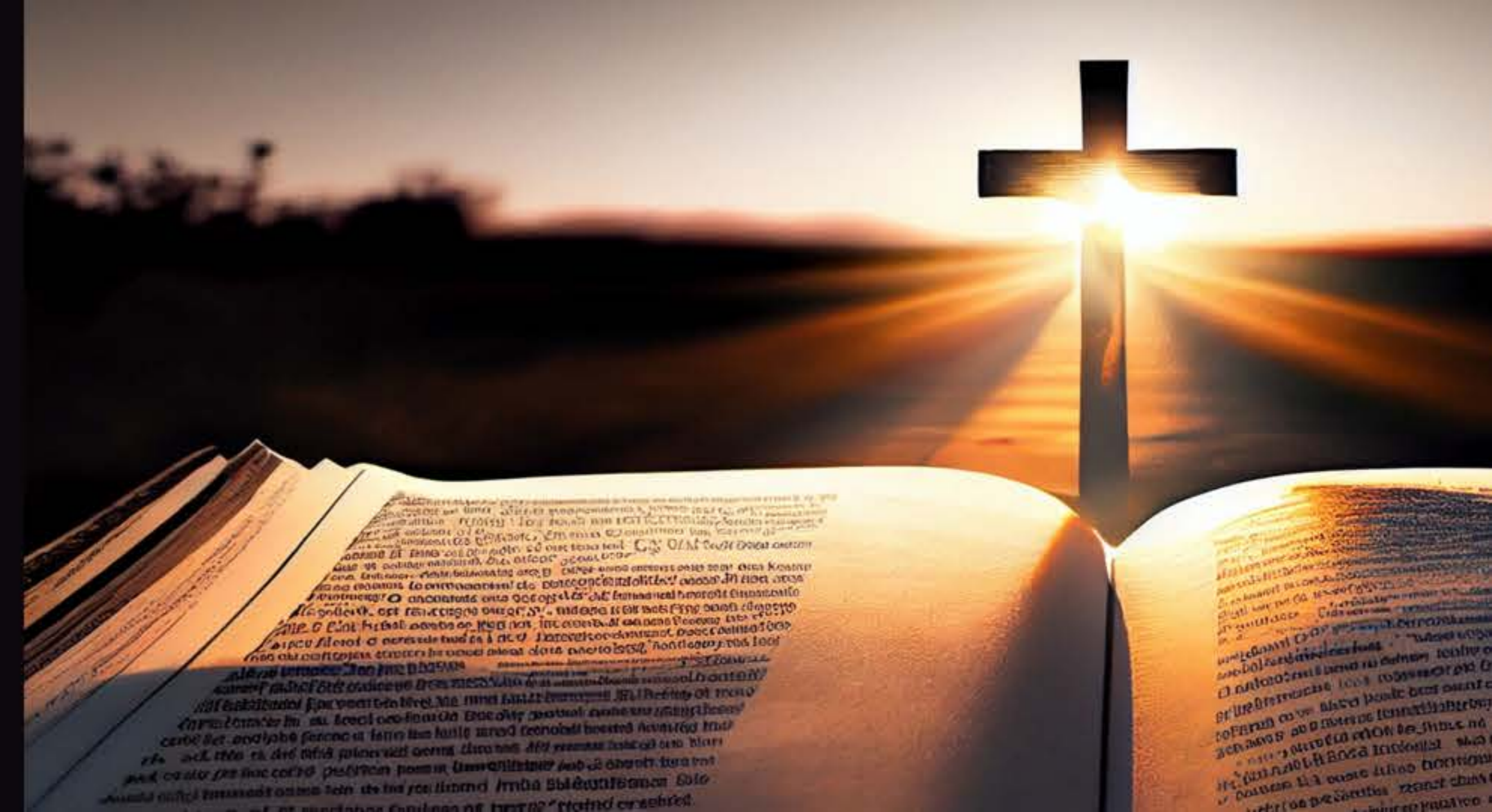
- Every **doctrine** must be based on the **weight** of Scriptures. **Ps119:160; Acts 20:27; 2Tim3:16-17**

Genesis 6:5, 11, 13

5 Then the Lord saw that the **wickedness of man was great** in the earth, and **that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.**

11 The earth also was **corrupt** before God, and the earth was **filled with violence.**

13 And God said to Noah, “The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is **filled with violence** through them; and behold, **I will destroy them with the earth.**”

I. Overview of Gentiles, Israel and the Church

- After Noah's flood, God called **Abram** to build a **nation (Israel)** separated from the rest.
- **Genesis 12:1-3**
1 Now the Lord had said to Abram ... **2** I will make you a great **nation**; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. **3** I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and **in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.**



- **Israel**
 - The nation of Israel: Israelites (Hebrews & Jews).
 - A people group.
- However, they rejected the prophets, priests and messengers of God and finally even killed the Lord Jesus, sent from God.



- **The Church** (John 3:16, 1:12, 5:24; Romans 10:9-10).
- **Everyone** (Jew or Gentile) who **believes and receives the Lord Jesus today** is a part of the **Church** (Galatians 3:26-28).
- Salvation is only possible when you believe in the Lord Jesus. This is clearly stated in the Bible, both the Old & New Testament.



- **No difference** between Jew or Gentile.
No favouritism.
- **True Jew** are circumcised in heart (Romans 2:29);
(not political, national, ethnic Israel/Jew).
- The Church is now. It began at Calvary/
Pentecost and will end at the Rapture.



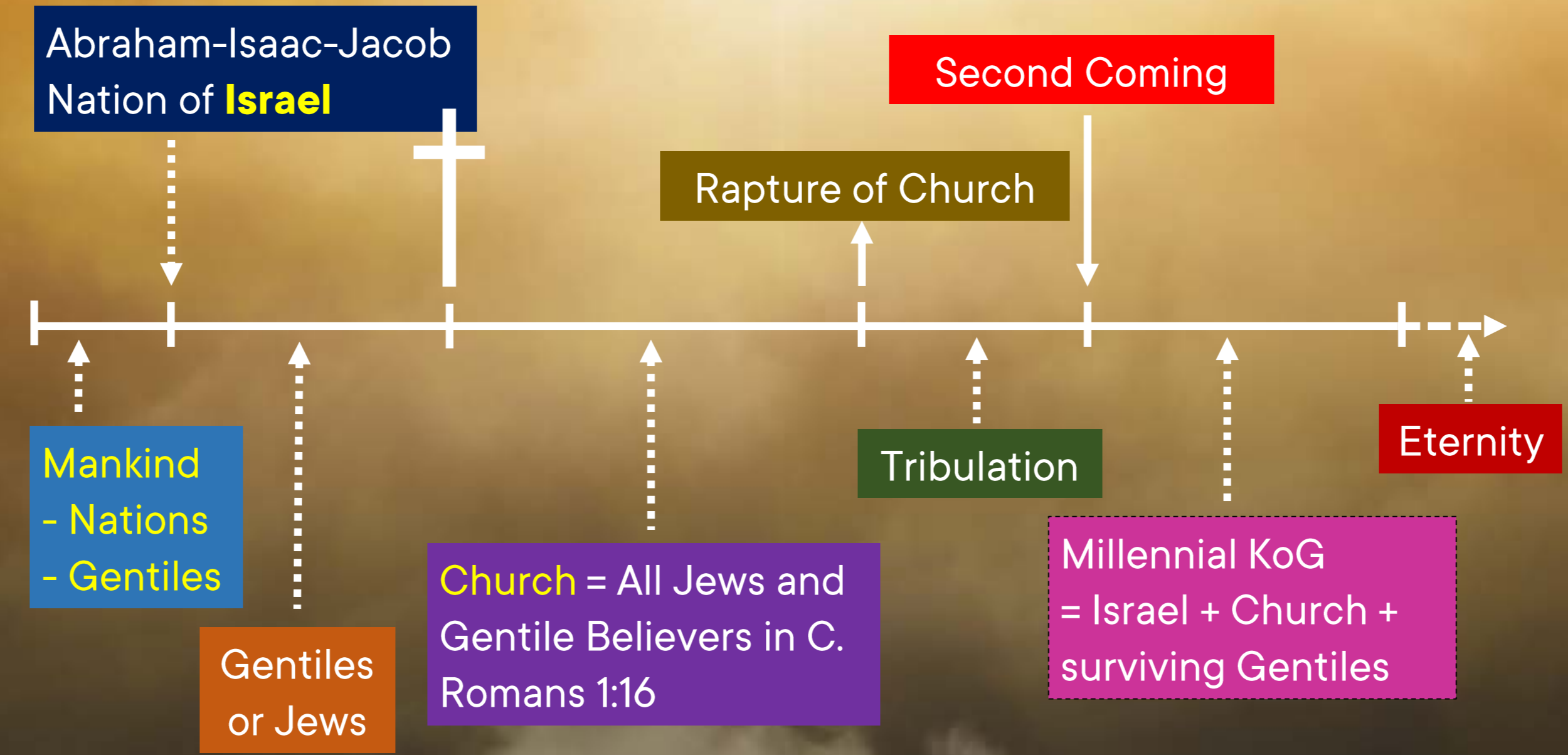

Daniel 9:24-26

24 Seventy weeks are determined for your people (Israel) and for your holy city (Jerusalem), to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy. **25** Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until **Messiah the Prince (the Lord Jesus),** there shall be **seven weeks and sixty-two weeks;** the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. **26** And **after the sixty-two weeks** Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the **people of the prince who is to come (Romans-AC)** shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined.

The Prophecy of Daniel's 70th week

Daniel 9:24a

70 weeks (70x7 years = 490 years) has been determined/
decreed for **Your people** and **Your Holy City**

Daniel 9:24 **Seventy weeks are determined for your people (Israel) and for your holy city (Jerusalem)**, to finish

the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

The Lord Jesus Christ came, at the end of the 69 weeks, **(7+62 weeks)** as the Messiah to fulfill **Daniel 9:24** for Israel but He was rejected and **Daniel 9:24** is NOT fulfilled for Israel!

Hence, **NONE** of the prophecies mentioned in **Daniel 9:24** has occurred for Israel.



Daniel's 70th week: **SUSPENDED**

Why? Because Israel rejected Jesus as their Messiah

- Israel has been looking for a political messiah during Jesus' time to save them from the Roman rule
- This is still true today. They are looking for someone to give them 'peace and security' in their land from enemies.
- Because of this desire, they will be deceived by the anti-Christ.



ISRAEL and the Messiah

- Israel has never believed till now that they need a “spiritual messiah” who can save them from their sins. They believe that the law of Moses is enough, even though we know that that isn’t, and no one is able to keep the law perfectly.



ISRAEL and the Messiah

- Jesus was the only One who did! He was both fully man and fully God.
- Israel wants a “warrior king”, not the suffering Servant who came and died for the sins of the world. He ascended to heaven, fulfilling another prophecy.



ISRAEL and the Messiah

- **Hosea 5:15** Then I will go back to my place until they admit their guilt. And they will seek my face; in their misery they will earnestly seek me.
- **Stephen** filled with the Holy Spirit in the early Church addressed the **Jewish Council in Acts 6-7**, tracing **God's Covenant with Abraham, Moses and David**.
- But they rejected Stephen's message from God and killed him.



ISRAEL and the Messiah

- God's dealings with **Israel (as a nation)** is now **“suspended”**.
- The Kingdom of God began with Israel (Exodus 19:5-6)
- Because of their disobedience and rejection of the Revelation of God, the Kingdom of God was taken from Israel and given to the Church.

11 I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But **through their fall**, to provoke them to jealousy, **salvation has come to the Gentiles.**


12 Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness!


15 For if their being cast away is the reconciling of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?



Romans 11:15, 20-23, 25, 26a

20 Well said. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear.

21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either. **22** Therefore consider **the goodness and severity of God**: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off. **23** And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.

A type of Church in Pre-Tribulation Rapture

Genesis 6-8 The Lord rescued Noah and his family in the ark.

A type of remnant Jew and believing Gentiles in the last 3-5 years of the Tribulation

Genesis 18-19 Sodom and Gomorrah
The Lord revealed His plans to Abram.
In the end, there was only one who was righteous - LOT

The Lord will always spare the righteous.

1 Thessalonians 1:10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead **even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath (of God) to come.**

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall **be saved from wrath** through Him.

The phrase '**THE DAY OF CHRIST**' appears only in the New Testament, and only in Paul's epistles.

THE DAY OF CHRIST = the Pre-Tribulation Rapture

Isaiah 13:9-11

9 Behold, the **day of the Lord** comes, **cruel**, with both **wrath** and **fierce anger**, to lay the **land desolate**; and He will **destroy** its sinners from it. 10 For the stars of heaven and their constellations will **not give their light**; the **sun** will be **darkened** in its going forth, and the **moon** will **not** cause its light to **shine**. 11 I will **punish** the **world** for its **evil**, and the **wicked** for their **iniquity**; I will halt the **arrogance** of the **proud**, and will lay low the **haughtiness** of the **terrible**.

Zephaniah 1:14-16

14 The **great day of the Lord** is near; it is near and hastens quickly. The noise of the day of the Lord is **bitter**; there the mighty men shall cry out. **15** That day is a **day of wrath**, a day of **trouble** and **distress**, a day of **devastation** and **desolation**, a day of **darkness** and **gloominess**, a day of **clouds** and **thick darkness**, **16** a day of trumpet and **alarm** against the fortified cities and against the high towers.

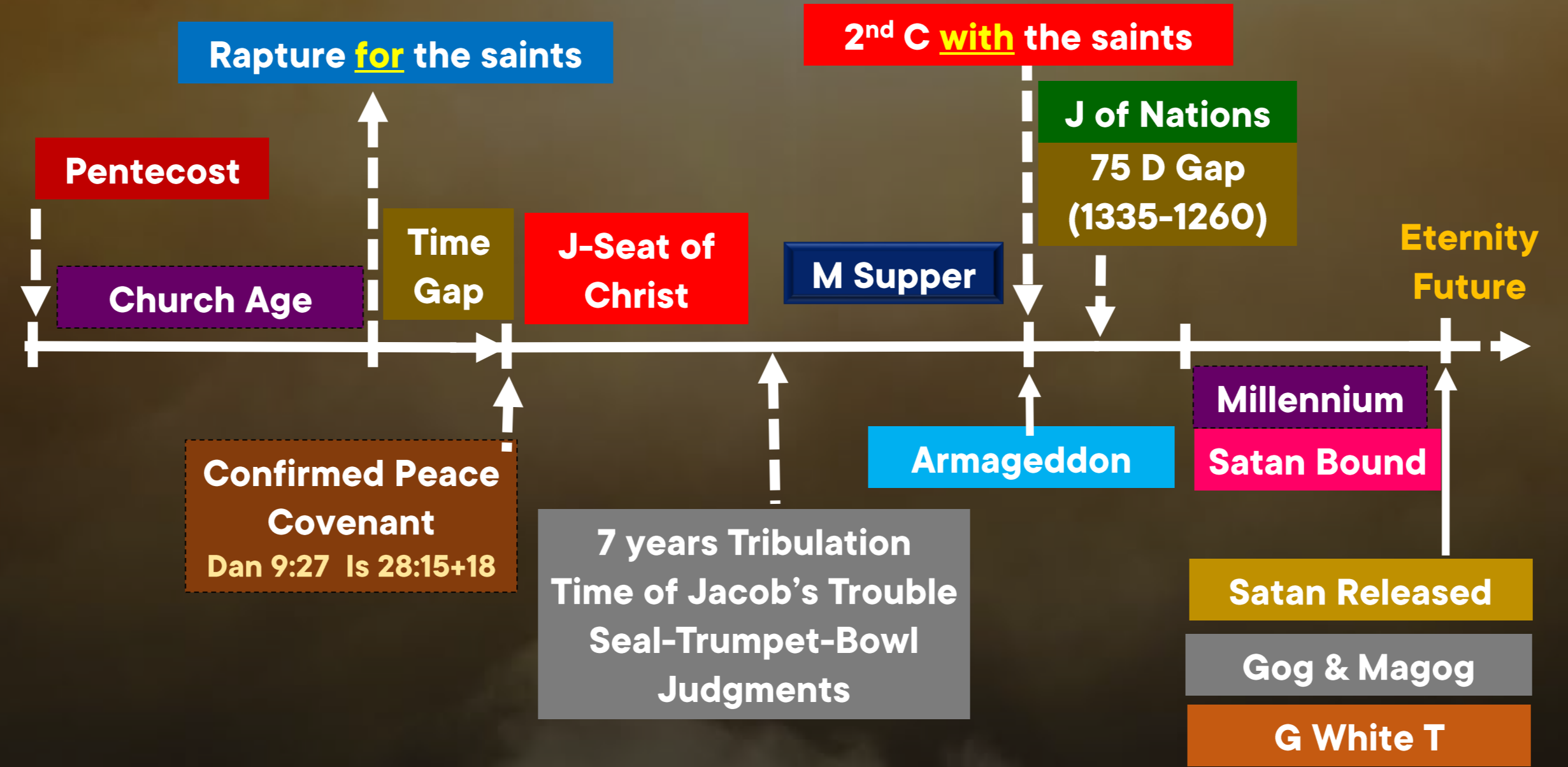

Post rapture (global chaos) - Likely events:

- **First Seal:** White Horseman
 - Revelation of the Anti-Christ to the world (2 Thessalonians 2:6-7)
- **Second Seal:** Red Horseman - War
- **Third Seal:** Black Horseman
 - Widespread famine, pestilence, economic upheaval
- **Fourth Seal:** Death and Hades
- **Fifth Seal:** Martyred Saints, fellow servants, their brethren
- Remaining Seal, Trumpets and Bowl Judgements
