


- 17 On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.

- 22 But I know that even now God will give you whatever you ask."


- 23 Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."

- 27 "Yes, Lord," she replied, "I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world."


- **32** When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."

CONTINUATIONALISM

Continuationalism holds that the spiritual gifts have "continued" unabated since Pentecost – even till today.

- Miracles throughout Bible, not just "key" prophets/Apostles. Indeed, miracles continue to be documented until today.
 - Eg 1: Balaam's donkey could miraculously speak! (Num 22)
 - **Eg 2:** NT miracles and tongues were sometimes even widespread (Acts 10:46, 19:6), not limited to the 12 Apostles.
- 2. No Scripture authoritatively, absolutely says gifts will cease. Eg 1 Cor 13 is referring to "when perfection comes" (v10)






ASSURANCE OF ANSWERED PRAYER



Eg: Prophets asking God to "take my life"! (Jonah 4:3, 1 Kings 19:4)





"Ask in faith, with no doubting, for **the one who doubts** ... must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord" (James 1:6–7).






- **39** "Take away the stone," he said. "But, Lord," said Martha, the sister of the dead man, "by this time there is a bad odour, for he has been there four days."
