

⁸ Now Amalek came and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

 - God commanded King Saul to do so.
- He failed and lost his kingdom.
 - The Amalekites were finally destroyed by King David.

- The Banner was the rod of Moses with which he performed miracles:
- ✓ brought the 10 plagues on Egypt
- ✓ parted the Red Sea and closed it
- ✓ smote the Rock and brought forth water

- e.g. 3: Death and life in the power of the tongue Proverbs 18:21

ENEMIES: The evil one

- Evil cannot harm us or touch us 1 John 5:18
- Unless we give him an open door Ephesians 4:27
- He goes about looking for vulnerabilities (open doors)
 1 Peter 5:8
- When we confess our sins, His blood covers us.
 (no more open doors) 1 John 1:9; Psalm 32:1

ENEMIES: The fallen world

but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.


John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation;

I. What are we being covered from?

ENEMIES: Rain, winds and floods

Matthew 7:24-25

II. WHO provides spiritual covering?

Our ultimate covering comes from GOD

Psalm 91:4 He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

Isaiah 51:16 And I have put My words in your mouth; I have **covered** you with the shadow of My hand, that I may plant the heavens, lay the foundations of the earth, and say to Zion, 'You *are* My people.

The efficacy and effectiveness of spiritual prayers:

James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

A righteous man = right standing + right believing + right doing

The efficacy and effectiveness of spiritual prayers:

- Personal prayer by yourself
- Prayer by someone in covenantal relationship with you
- Prayer by a godly person
- Prayer by fellow brothers/sisters in the church



III. HOW are we covered spiritually?

2 Samuel 10:9-12

IV. WHAT do we need to know about spiritual covering?

1. When we submit to God's delegated authority over us as unto the Lord, we will receive blessings
The blessings include:

ROTECTION	PROVISION	PEACE	FAVOUR

Psalm 84:11 For the LORD God *is* a sun and shield; the LORD will give grace and glory; **no good thing will He withhold** from those who walk uprightly.



IV. WHAT do we need to know about spiritual covering?

2. When we do not submit to God's delegated authority over us, we reap negative consequences

Romans 13:2 Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry ...

3. The only exception to submission to God's delegated authority is when it causes us to violate the laws of God

Acts 5:29 ... we must obey God rather than men ...

IV. WHAT do we need to know about spiritual covering?

(2) Non-routine days = "Extra" covering: WHY

Matthew 12:43-45

43 When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest (harmony-environment), and finds none. 44 Then he says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when he comes, he finds it **empty**, swept, and put in order. ⁴⁵ Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation.'



IV. WHAT do we need to know about spiritual covering?

- (2) Non-routine days = "Extra" covering: WHY?
- Vigilance in 2 basic situations: Matthew 12:43-45
- (A) When the believer makes a significant decision towards God (godliness; spirituality) Matthew8:9-df
- (B) When the believer brings the Kingdom of God into lives and situations. Stepping up in ministry

1 John 1:7 ... we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Matthew 6:14-15

14 For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

5. We can lose our protection/covering
 This happens when we(3) are disconnected from the body-life (the church)

James 5:19-20

¹⁹ ... if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, ²⁰ let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.



5. We can lose our protection/covering
This happens when we

- (1) do not walk in obedience
- (2) have a spirit of unforgiveness
- (3) are disconnected from the body-life (the church)

When disconnected, this means that you may be further exposed to evil (e.g. witchcraft and curses)

Proverbs 26:2 Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, so a curse without cause shall not alight.

Exodus 17:8-16

- The Amalekites represent the spiritual forces arrayed against us., especially children and women.
- Israel's best men by themselves couldn't defeat them
- Only by spiritual covering/warfare
- Joshua needed Moses/Aaron and Hur to cover him
