

Passover (v7): you shall not do any ordinary work

Pentecost (v21): you shall not do any ordinary work

Tabernacles (v36): you shall not do any ordinary work



[7-yearly] Leviticus 25:4

In the seventh year the land is to have a year of sabbath rest, a sabbath to the LORD. Do not sow your fields or prune your vineyards.



[50-yearly] Leviticus 25:10

Consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you.




Exodus 16:23, 30

On the sixth day, they gathered twice as much food—two omers per person—and all the leaders of the congregation came and reported this to Moses.




Leviticus 25:21-22


Leviticus 26:34

Then the land will enjoy its sabbath years all the time that it lies desolate and you are in the country of your enemies; then the land will rest and enjoy its sabbaths.





2 Chronicles 36:21

Stop bringing meaningless offerings! Your incense is detestable to me. New Moons, Sabbaths and convocations — I cannot bear your worthless assemblies.




[rebellion] Isaiah 58:13




Amos 8:5

Luke 6:7


The Pharisees and the teachers of the law were looking for a reason to accuse Jesus, so they watched him closely to see if he would heal on the Sabbath.

But Jesus replied, "My Father is always working, and so am I."






