In prayer, we pause to adore God.




# Align.

Some people are allergic to asking anything of God.


"No lah, no need lah.

### WHY DO SOME PRAYERS GO UNANSWERED?

Some things remain mysteries. PERHAPS ...

- 1. You're not asking something in God's will Grow in intimacy, Word
- 2. There are blockages in your spiritual life Confess, repent, RTF
- 3. God's "No"/ "Wait" may be for your good Grow in discernment
- 4. God answers in HIS good time, not yours Patience, Perseverance



Some people are **allergic** to asking anything of God.

Then there are some for whom prayer is only about asking God for things.





Key #1: Ask God according to His will.

Too often, we impose our will on God.
Instead, if you **know** the will of God,
and you are **aligned** with the will of God,
then **everything you ask**will be **according to His will**.

Why would He say no to Himself?



Key #1: Ask God according to His will.

The will of God for us is:

To be holy/sanctified/devoted to Him (1 Thess 4:3)

To do what is right (James 4:17)

To do good works (1 Peter 2:15)

To be thankful in all circumstances (1 Thess 5:18)

If what you ask is aligned with His will, why would He say no to Himself?



Key #1: Ask God according to His will.

And how will we know His will?

1. It is revealed in the Word of God.

How can a young person stay on the path of purity?

By living according to Your Word.

I seek You with all my heart;

Do not let me stray from Your commands.

I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You.

Psalm 119:9-11



Key #1: Ask God according to His will.

And how will we know His will?

1. It is revealed in the Word of God.

2. It is revealed through the Spirit of God.

...No one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.

What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us.

1 Corinthians 2:11-12.

Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

Do not get drunk on wine... Instead, be filled with the Spirit. Eph 5:17-18



Key #1: Ask God according to His will.

And how will we know His will?

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God – His good, acceptable and perfect will.

Romans 12:2



### Key #2: Know that Father God delights in giving to His children!

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you ... Which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!"

Matthew 7:7-11 reminds us not to operate out of an orphan spirit!



Key #3: Ask for others, not just for ourselves

#### 2 CHRONICLES 1:6-12

- 6 Solomon went to the bronze altar before the Lord in the tent of meeting and offered a thousand burnt offerings on it. 7 That night God appeared to Solomon and said to him, "Ask for whatever you want Me to give you."
- 8 Solomon answered God, "You have shown great kindness to David my father and have made me king in his place.
- 9 Now, Lord God, let Your promise to my father David be confirmed, for You have made me king over a people who are as numerous as the dust of the earth."



## 3 Keys to Asking God

Key #3: Ask for others, not just for ourselves

#### 2 CHRONICLES 1:6-12

- 10 "Give me wisdom and knowledge, that I may lead this people, for who is able to govern this great people of Yours?"
- 11 God said to Solomon, "Since this is your heart's desire and you have not asked for wealth, possessions or honour, nor for the death of your enemies, and since you have not asked for a long life but for wisdom and knowledge to govern My people over whom I have made you king,
- therefore wisdom and knowledge will be given you. And I will also give you wealth, possessions and honour, such as no king who was before you ever had and none after you will have."
