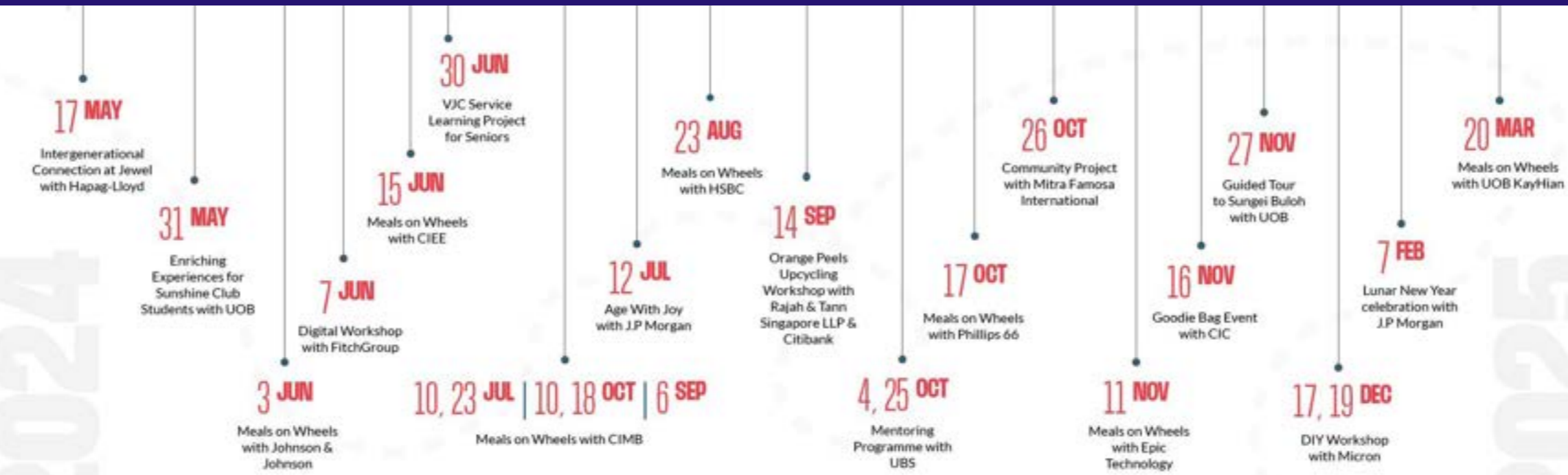

- Cleanse those with leprosy

Leviticus 13:10-13

10 The priest is to examine them, and if there is a white swelling in the skin that has turned the hair white and if there is raw flesh in the swelling, **11** it is a chronic skin disease and the priest shall pronounce them unclean. He is not to isolate them, because they are already unclean.



- Cleanse those with leprosy

Leviticus 13:12-13

12 If the disease breaks out all over their skin and, so far as the priest can see, it covers all the skin of the affected person from head to foot, **13** the priest is to examine them, and if the disease has covered their whole body, he shall pronounce them clean. Since it has all turned white, they are clean.

The Essence of Christian Life

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now these three remain:
faith, hope and **love**. But the greatest of these is love.



FAITH

Hebrews 11:1 Now **faith** is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

Hebrews 11:6 And without **faith** it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.



HOPE

Romans 15:13 May the God of **hope** fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with **hope** by the power of the Holy Spirit.



LOVE

Matthew 22:37-39

37 Jesus replied: “**Love** the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’

38 This is the first and greatest commandment.

39 And the second is like it: ‘**Love** your neighbor as yourself.



LOVE

1 Corinthians 13:4-8a

4 Love is patient, **love** is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. **5** It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. **6 Love** does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. **7** It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. **8 Love** never fails.



Romans 8:37-39

37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. **38** For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, **39** neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
