

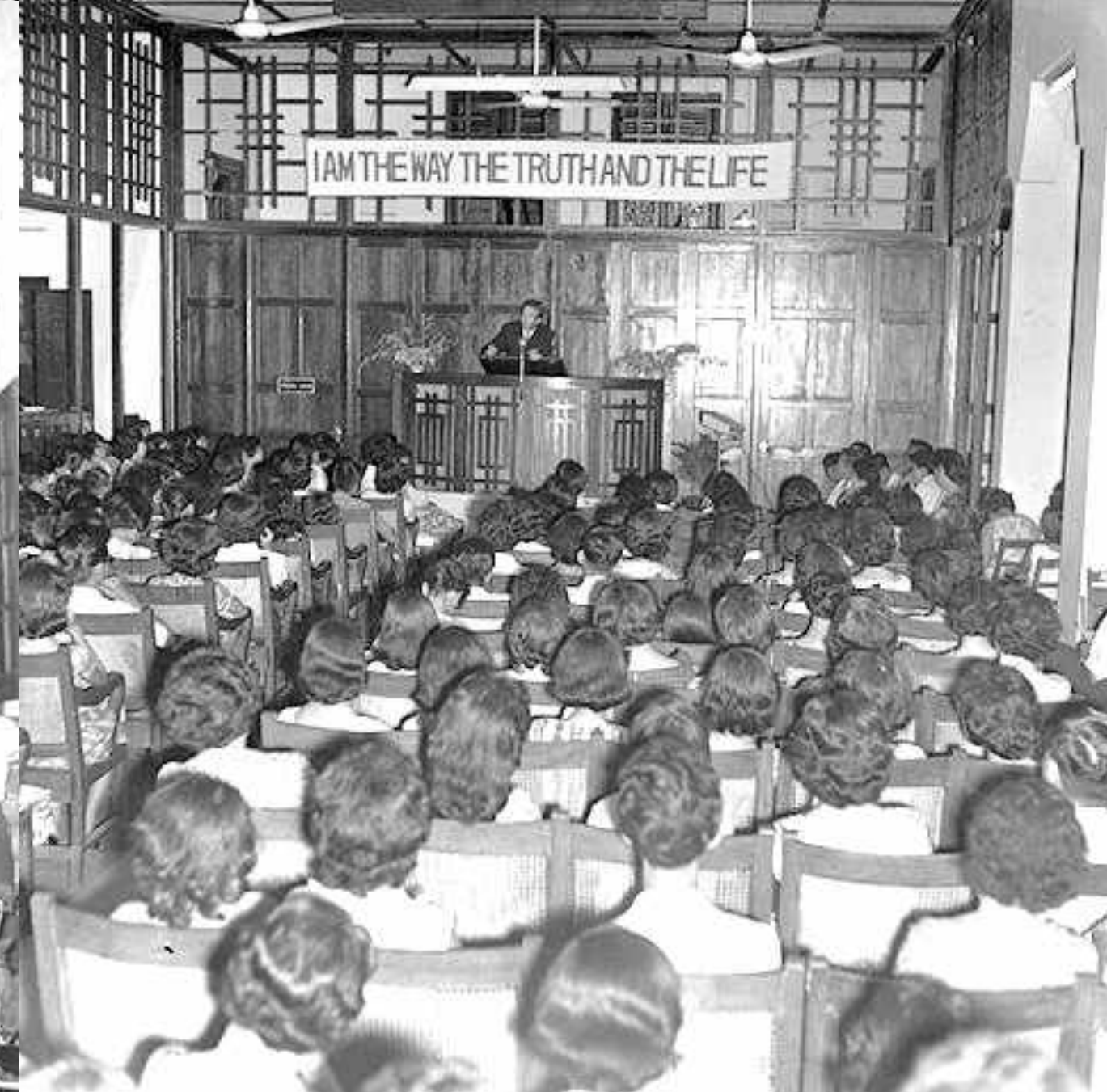

### Exodus 35: Building the Tabernacle

- 4 Moses said to all the congregation of the children of Israel:  
This is the thing which the Lord commanded, saying:
- 5 Take an offering to the Lord. Whoever is of a willing heart,  
let him bring it as an offering to the Lord: Gold, silver, bronze ...
- 6-9 (and linen, animal skins, wood, oil, spices, gemstones ...)

## Exodus 35: Building the Tabernacle

- 10 Every skilled craftsman among you shall come and make all that the Lord has commanded:
- 11 the tabernacle with its tent and its covering, its hooks and its boards, its bars, its pillars, -and its sockets;
- 12 the ark with its poles, the mercy seat, and the veil that conceals it;
- 13-19 *The table • lampstand • incense altar • altar of burnt offering • curtains • pegs • holy garments for Aaron and his sons, the priests.*

### Exodus 35: Building the Tabernacle

- 20 Then all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses.
- 21 Everyone whose heart stirred him, everyone whose spirit was willing came and brought the Lord's offering for the work of the tent of meeting and for all its service and for the holy garments.
- 22 They came, both men and women, as many as had willing hearts, and brought brooches, earrings, rings and bracelets, all kinds of gold jewelry, and everyone that offered an offering of gold to the Lord.

### Exodus 35: Building the Tabernacle

- 23 Everyone who had blue, purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' hair, and red skins of rams, and porpoise skins, brought them.
- 24 Everyone who was making a contribution of silver and bronze brought the Lord's offering, and everyone who had acacia wood for any work of the service brought it.
- 25 All the women that were skilled spun with their hands and brought what they had spun, both of blue, purple, and scarlet, and fine linen.
- 26 All the women whose hearts stirred them to action and were skilled spun goats' hair.

## Exodus 35: Building the Tabernacle

- 27 The leaders brought onyx stones and gemstones to be set for the ephod and for the breastplate,
- 28 and spice and oil for the light, and for the anointing oil, and for the fragrant incense.
- 29 The children of Israel brought a willing offering to the Lord, every man and woman whose heart was willing to bring material for all the work which the Lord had commanded through Moses to be made.

**What does it take to build the House of the Lord?**

**Not just things.**

**Yes, it needs raw materials.**

**Yes, it needs wood, stones, cloth.**

**Yes, it needs precious items, some very expensive.**

**But things are meaningless unless there are people using them.**



**What does it take to build the House of the Lord?**

**Not just leaders.**

**Yes, it needs the Lord (of course!).**

**Yes, it needs a Moses and an Aaron. Appointed leaders.**

**Yes, it needs the master craftsmen. Building experts.**

**But it can't happen without all the people. Every man and woman.**

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

It starts with a command ...

35:4 “This is the thing which the Lord commanded”

35:10 “Come and make all that the Lord has commanded”

35:29 “All the work which the Lord had commanded through Moses”

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

**But a command is useless until it is obeyed.**

35:5 “Whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it”

35:21 “Everyone whose heart stirred him and everyone whose spirit was willing came and brought the Lord’s offering”

35:22 “They came, both men and women, as many as had willing hearts”

35:26 “All the women whose hearts stirred them to action”

35:29 “The children of Israel brought a willing offering to the Lord, every man and woman whose heart was willing”

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

### A. Sometimes, we are unwilling to obey God.

- **Eg 1. Achan** in Joshua 7 – hiding wartime plunder under his tent.
- **Eg 2. Ananias and Sapphira** in Acts 5 – hiding money from God.  
“Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money?”

ACTS 5:3

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

**B. Sometimes, we are unwilling to believe God is calling us.**

- **Take the Call of Moses.**
- First, God gives His Purpose.  
“I send you to Pharaoh to bring my people out of Egypt.” **EXODUS 3:10**
- But Moses asks: What if no one believes me? **EXODUS 4:1**
- Then he adds: I am not eloquent enough. **EXODUS 4:10**

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

### B. Sometimes, we are unwilling to believe God is calling us.

- In response, God gives His Power.  
A staff that turns into a snake. Skin that turns leprous and back.  
Water that turns into blood. Signs/wonders Man cannot do – “so that they may believe that the Lord has appeared to you.” **EXODUS 4:5**
- Also, God gives His People.  
We cannot serve and survive alone! “What about your brother Aaron? I will help both of you speak and will teach you what to do.” **EXODUS 4:14**

## What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

### 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

**B. Sometimes, we are unwilling to believe God is calling us.**

- **Despite all this, Moses just does not want to obey.**
- Moses said, "Pardon your servant, Lord. Please send someone else."  
**Then the Lord's anger burned against Moses.** EXODUS 4:13-14
- **God gives his Purpose, Power and People!**  
Don't let your past baggage, personality and preferences stop you from stepping up to the privilege of serving Him!

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

### C. Sometimes, we may even obey, but unwillingly.

- **Eg 1. Jonah** – upset that the Ninevites are allowed to repent!  
“That is why I tried to flee to Tarshish. I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who relents from sending calamity.” **JONAH 4:2**
- **Eg 2. Thomas** – “Let us also go, that we may die with him.” **JOHN 11:16**

# What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

## 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

Two ways to respond to God's command: Unwillingly vs Willingly.

**God is seeking willing hearts!**

- The people could have been forced to give towards the tabernacle. But God doesn't need their money!
- “Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord?  
To obey is better than sacrifice,  
and to heed is better than the fat of rams.” 1 SAMUEL 15:22

## What does it take to build the House of the Lord?

### 1. OUR OBEDIENCE

To build the House, we must follow the Head of the House.

**We build His House His way – not ours.**

“Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God’s people and also members of his household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets,

**with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone.**

**In Him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord.”**

EPHESIANS 2:19-21
