

Prayer Meditation

1 John 1:9: confess specific wrongs you've done.

Receive:

- forgiveness
- cleansing
- covering

Guilt free - no condemnation!

- Rest: sleep
- Exercise: bodily movements
- Diet: nutrition
- Peace-shalom: release good elements in the body
